

MetLife Contact Information:

This information is to walk all Current Employees through the process of opening their own claim with Current's Leave of Absence Policy. This includes Short-Term Disability, Family and Medical Leave, and *Paid Family Medical Leave with our carrier, MetLife.

Step 1: Log onto www.mybenefits.metlife.com

If you are a first-time user, you will need to "Register" yourself



Step 2: Select the name of the company funding the Benefit- Current Lighting Holdco, Inc.



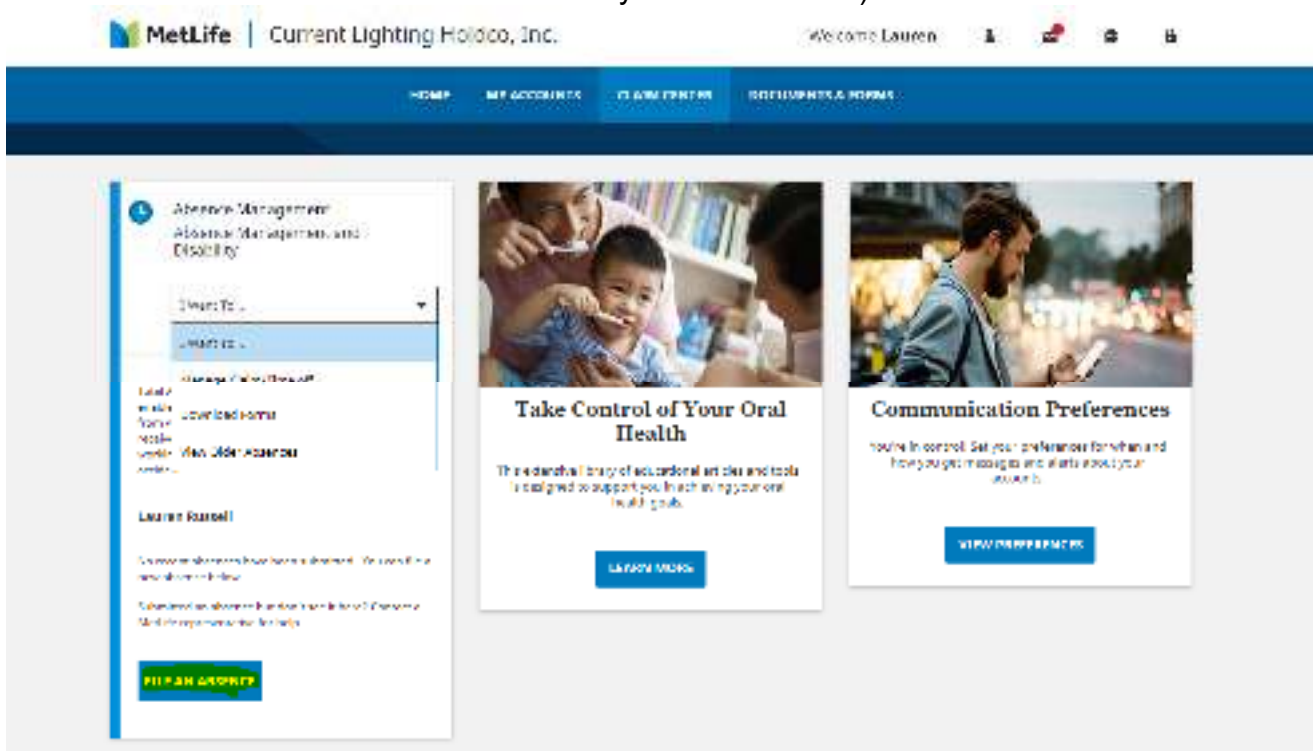
*Paid Family Medical Leave (PFML) is a state mandated benefit. Please see your Human Resource professional to see if you state is applicable.

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Step 3: Once logged into “MyBenefits” with MetLife you can see the portal dashboard. From here you can request a new dental card, update your demographics, and open a claim by selecting “View the Claim Center”



Step 4: Within the “Claims Center” you can open manage existing claims, download MetLife Forms, and view previous absences filed with MetLife. You can additionally “File An Absence” for an upcoming Leave of Absence (Short-Term Disability, Family and Medical Leave, and/or *Paid Family Medical Leave.)



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Step 5: When opening your claim please be sure to have all your information ready. Contact information for yourself, supervisor, and provider are necessary when filing a claim. Additional questions may be asked regarding your hourly/ annual salary and work schedule. Please be sure to select the "Other Claim" even for illness.
